～ In preparation for the opening of Osaka Station (Umekita area)～
Suspension of Limited Express “HARUKA”, “KUROSHIO” services and traffic regulations due to track works

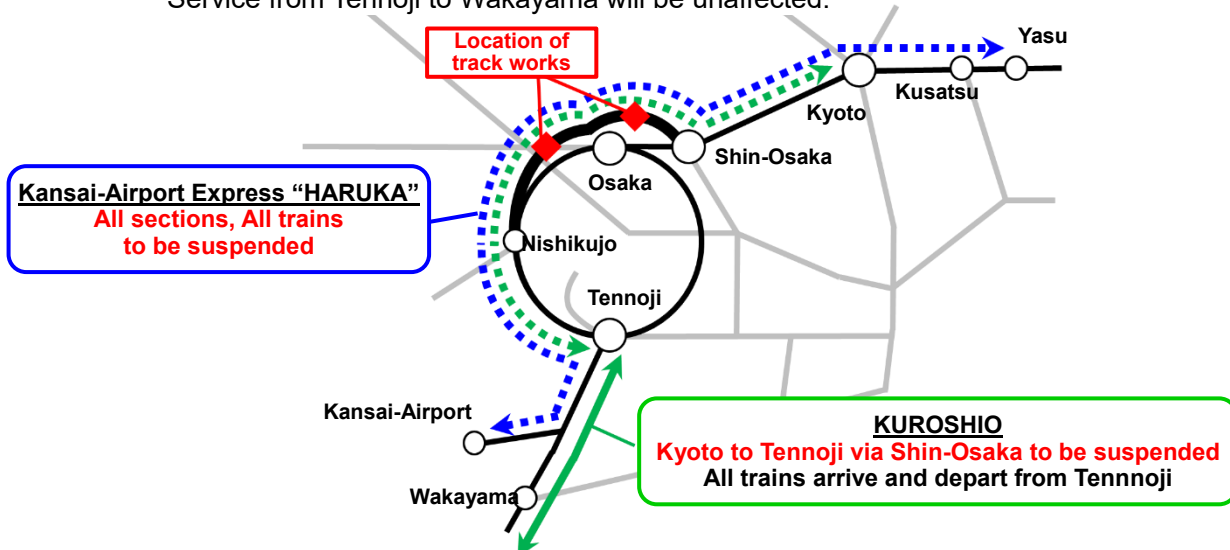
In preparation for the opening of Osaka Station (Umekita area), all sections of the Kansai-Airport Express “HARUKA” and some sections of the Limited Express “KUROSHIO” will be suspended. Along with this construction work, traffic regulations will be conducted in some sections of the Naniwa-suji (prefectural road No. 41). We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and ask for your understanding and cooperation.

1. Track work details

- (1) Duration: From the night of Sat., February 11, 2023 to the early morning of Mon., February 13, 2023.
- (2) Location: Two track sections between Shin-Osaka and Nishikujo Stations
* Kansai-Airport Express “HARUKA”, Limited Express “KUROSHIO” and freight trains run on this track.

2. Suspension of Limited Express services

- (1) Date: All day on Sunday, February 12, 2023.
- (2) Area: - All sections of the Kansai-Airport Express “HARUKA” service.
- Limited Express “KUROSHIO” service between Kyoto to Tennoji via Shin-Osaka.*
* Service from Tennoji to Wakayama will be unaffected.



3. Replacement transportation

- No replacement or substitute transportation will be provided.
* Trains will operate as usual except for the above mentioned “HARUKA” and “KUROSHIO” services.

4. Traffic regulations

- (1) Duration: From 22:00 on Saturday, February 11, 2023, to 6:00 on Monday, February 13, 2023.
- (2) Location: Some sections of Naniwa-suji (Prefectural Road No. 41).
