Proposition No. 1: Appropriation of retained earnings

The Company recognizes it important to distribute profits to its shareholders on a long-term and constant basis and subject to its projects yielding results, aims to attain a 3% ratio of dividends to shareholders' equity on a consolidated basis (consolidated DOE) for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2013.

Proposition No. 4: Dismissal of Director

♦ Summary of the proposition

It is hereby proposed that Director Makoto Shibata be dismissed.

♦ Reasons for the proposition

West Japan Railway Company publicized on March 19, 2012 that an employee at the Akashi station had embezzled approximately \(\xi\)86,000,000 by illegally reissuing commuter tickets and then giving refunds to himself and another employee at the Shin-Sanda station had embezzled approximately \(\xi\)160,000. It was also publicized in February 2012 that an employee at the Tenma station had embezzled approximately \(\xi\)24,000,000 and an employee

at the Itsukaichi station had embezzled approximately ¥8,700,000. The amount of damage totaled approximately ¥118,860,000. The Company, which has admitted, "Our measures to prevent money troubles have been improper," has imposed a disciplinary sanction of "a return of 10% of a monthly remuneration and a portion of officer's remuneration for one month" on Director Makoto Shibata acting as General Manager of Marketing Division. The sanction is too lenient. Director Makoto Shibata acting as General Manager of Marketing Division is obligated to supervise station employees and if he had directed his full attention to supervisory duties, such criminal acts would have been prevented. He is highly responsible for his failure to supervise the employees that resulted in many stations forming hotbeds of criminal acts. Consequently, it has not only caused considerable losses to our shareholders but substantially undermined the credibility of the Company. Therefore, Director Makoto Shibata acting as General Manager of Marketing Division is disqualified.

Opinion of the Board of Directors

The Company has been exerting its efforts to develop and improve appropriate schemes to comply with laws, regulations and rules throughout its business activities by clearly defining the functions and powers of its organization units and giving education, training and guidance to its employees.

With that background, Mr. Makoto Shibata, as Director, Senior Executive Officer and General Manager of Marketing Division, has made his all-out efforts to engage in the above-mentioned activities, promote steady development of the system to properly carry on operations at its stations, carry out various marketing activities to boost tourist demand and provide quality services to our customers.

Reflecting seriously on the misconduct of our employees concerning the reissue of commuter tickets and other incidents that were revealed recently, he has implemented immediate preventive measures.

In so doing, he has performed his duties as Director faithfully in accordance with laws and ordinances and the Articles of Incorporation of the Company. The Company has found no reason to dismiss him.

Therefore, the Board of Directors objects to this proposition.
