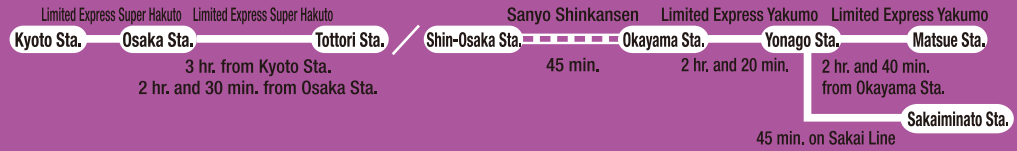
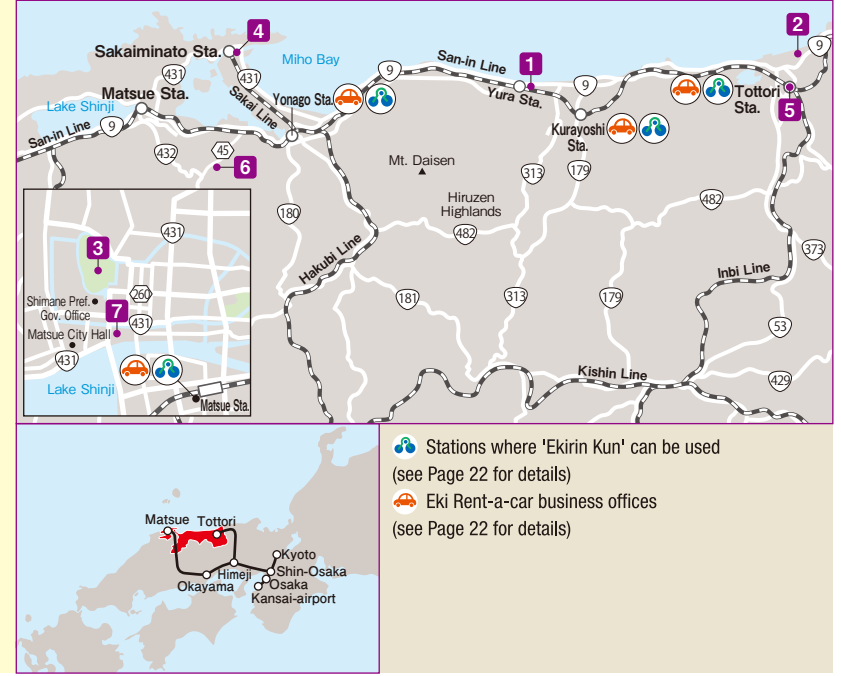

Take a Nihon Kotsu Bus at Tottori Station, get off at Sunano Bijutsukan-mae bus stop and it will be a short walk.

\*Only available to people who present a pass.

Take a Matsue Lakeline Bus at Matsue Station, get off at Kokuho Matsuejo (Otemae) bus stop and walk 8 min.  
 8:30-18:00 (Last admission), Oct.-Mar.: until 16:30 (Last admission)  
 ¥ Admission free to enter the hommaru palace. To climb the castle keep: Adults ¥560, children ¥280

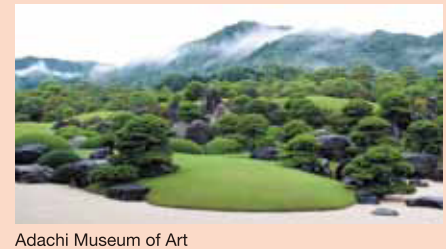
Take a Lakeline Bus at Matsue Station, get off at Otemae Horikawa Yuransen Noriba bus stop and it will be a short walk. ③ Mar. 1-June 30, Sep. 1-Oct. 10: 9:00-17:00, July 1-Aug. 31: until 18:00, Oct. 11-Feb.: until 16:00 ¥ Adults ¥1,230 ④ In operation every day (May be closed in the case of bad weather.)

**Free Rent-a-cycle**

[Service details] 1. Present your JR-WEST RAIL PASS at the following participating stores. You can use a rental bicycle for the day. 2. The model lent out will be a 26-inch light roadster or a pedelec. 3. Reservations are not taken. Bicycles will be available on a first come, first served basis. \*There is a limited number of bicycles, so at times none will be available. The number of bicycles available will depend on the store. 4. Children age 11 or younger may not use the service. 5. Customers are responsible for accidents, thefts, losses or breakdowns of bicycles while they are lent out.
