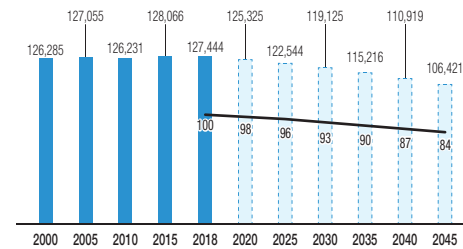

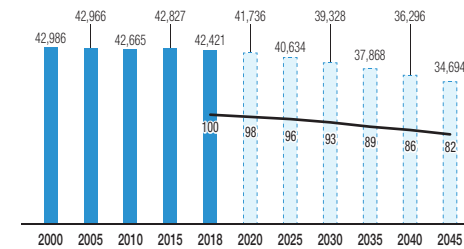
## MAP OF WEST JAPAN AND POPULATION GROWTH IN KANSAI AREA

■ Actual □ Projection ● Change

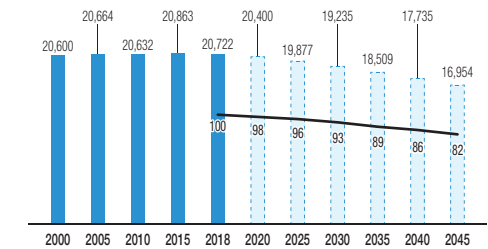
Japan Total

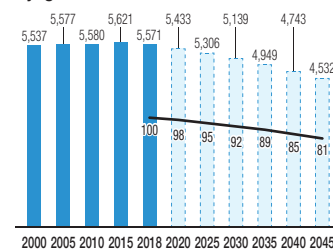

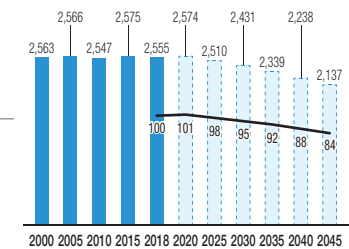

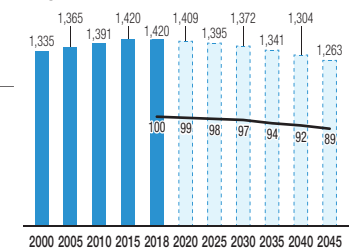
