So that foreign visitors to Japan can enjoy touring across a wide area, we are now introducing the Osaka-Tokyo Hokuriku Arch Pass for economical travel from Osaka and Tokyo to the Hokuriku area. With this pass, visitors can travel from the Kansai, Narita, and Haneda international airports to the Hokuriku area by Hokuriku Shinkansen, limited express trains, and other services.
