It will become a brilliantly-colored field of flowers containing a wide range of flowers including such autumn favorites as dahlias, marigolds, and zinnias, as well as popular flowers such as hydrangeas, Rieger begonias, and flannel flowers. The unusual hues of the chocolate cosmos and capsicum will also be added to the range of colors. We hope that visitors will enjoy relaxing and strolling around, and maybe taking lovely photos of flowers that catch their eye.

O Color design flower garden

This year we have experimented for the first time with creating a design with five different flower colors that continues across three areas. We hope that visitors will enjoy the color design garden, which is slightly different from the other gardens.

There is plenty to see in this year's Toki-no-hiroba Plaza, with some areas bringing together different flowers with the same color, and some created on different levels. In addition, the plaza is dotted with various ornaments that create the mood of a flower garden.
