All of Kansai-Airport Express "HARUKA" services will resume operation

Due to the impact of the new coronavirus, some trains of Kansai-Airport Express "HARUKA" has been suspended since September 1, 2020. However, due to the expected increase in use of Kansai International Airport following the upcoming relaxation of border measures, all "HARUKA" trains will resume operation from November 1.

1. Operation Plan

- (1) Operation Resume Date: November 1, 2022
- (2) Trains to resume operation
 - 22 trains of Kansai-Airport Express "HARUKA"

(from Kyoto to Kansai-Airport: 11trains, from Kansai-Airport to Kyoto: 11 trains.)

- * The number of daily operations will increase from 38 to 60.
- (3) Time of resuming operation

Arriving and departing at Kansai-Airport between 10:00 and 22:00

* About 2 trains per hour
