#### 1 Osaka Station City



Includes the North and South Gate buildings, with JR Osaka Station at the center. A popular new spot for shopping and dining.  
Directions: get off at JR Osaka Station

#### 2 Kurashiki Bikan Historical District



The river's surface mirrors a white-walled mansion and a line of willows. This popular area affords gorgeous views. Also home to the Ohara Museum of Art, housing world-class works of art.  
Directions: take a bus from JR Kurashiki Station (a few minutes), or walk (15 min)

#### 3 Dogo Onsen



One of Japan's Three Old Springs. The communal baths and Dogo Onsen's Main building was constructed in 1894. An important cultural asset.  
Directions: take the Metropolitan train from JR Matsuyama Stn. (20 mins) and get off at "Dogo Onsen"

#### 4 Itsukushima Shrine (Miyajima)

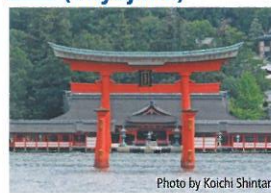

One of the Three Views of Japan. Is known for the large shrine gate floating in the sea and its shrine pavilions, and is a World Heritage Site, as is Misen in the background.  
Directions: Get off at JR Miyajimaguchi Stn., transfer to the ferry (10 mins)

#### 5 Kumamoto Castle

One of the most famous castles in Japan. It is known for its imposing keep and beautiful stone walls, called Seishoryu.  
Directions: take a bus from JR Kumamoto Stn. to "Kumamotojo Ninomaru Chushajo"

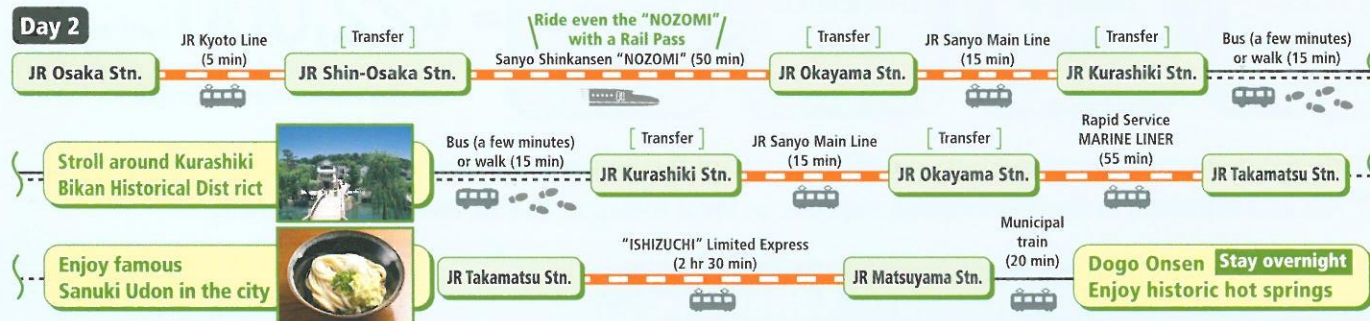

 not included in the price of a JR-Sanyo-Shikoku-Kyushu RAIL PASS

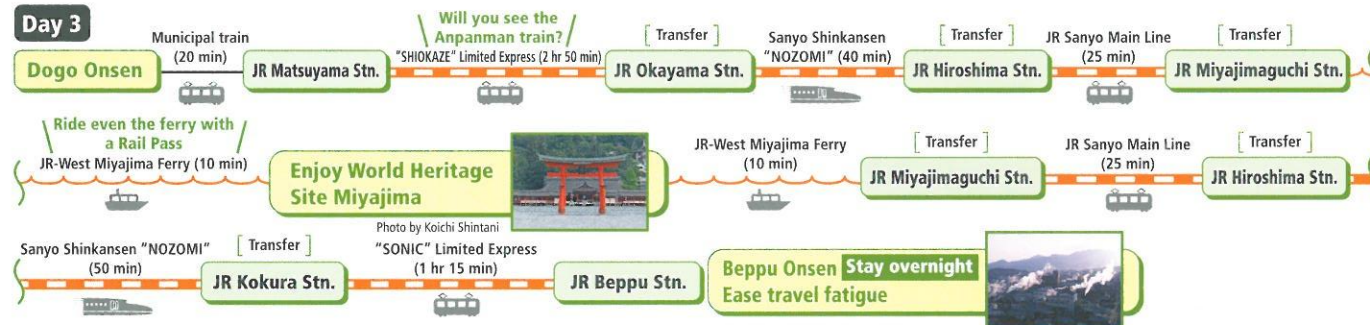

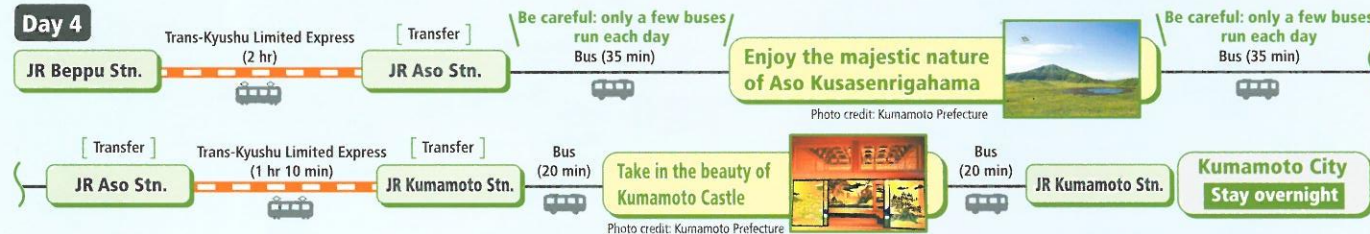

## Please Read

### Purchase Eligibility

● Rail passes are provided only for travelers who have passports issued by governments other than Japan, who have short-term stay visas, and who can show return tickets (including e-tickets) as well as ED cards.

\*When purchasing, you will be asked to provide your name, country of residence, passport number, travel start date, and other required information on the application form.

### Purchase Locations

● If purchasing through an overseas travel agency, etc. (from June 2012)

● MCOs can be purchased from the following companies' sales offices or from participating travel agencies. JAL, ANA, JTB, Nippon Travel Agency, Kinki Nippon Tourist (KNT), Toptour, or Jalpak

● After arriving in Japan, MCOs can be exchanged for rail passes at the following JR train station counters.

[JR-West] Shin-Osaka Stn., Osaka Stn., Sannomiya Stn., Kansai Airport Stn., Okayama Stn., Hiroshima Stn., Shimonoseki Stn., Kokura Stn., and Hakata Stn.

[JR Shikoku] Warp Takamatsu, Warp Matsuyama, Warp Tokushima, Warp Kochi, and Warp Umeda branches

[JR Kyushu] JR Kyushu Travel Agency offices at Kokura, Hakata, Saga, Nagasaki, Oita, Kumamoto,

as well as Mojiko Stn. (has a Travel Center), Kokura Stn., Hakata Stn., Saga Stn., Nagasaki Stn., Beppu Stn. (has a Travel Center), Oita Stn., and Kumamoto Stn.

● When purchasing passes within Japan

● Passes may be purchased with cash or credit cards at counters and other locations at the below JR stations.
